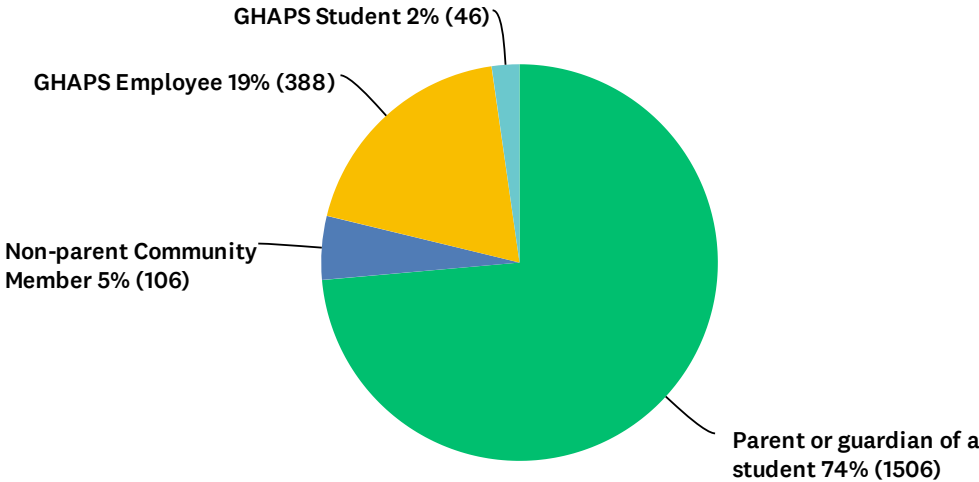

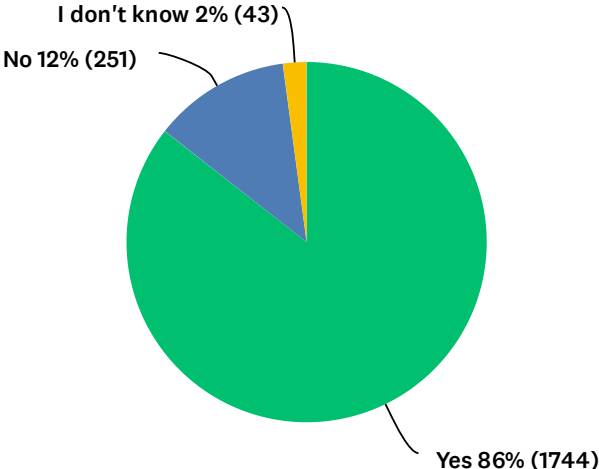

Q2 Are you a registered voter within Grand Haven Area Public School district boundaries?

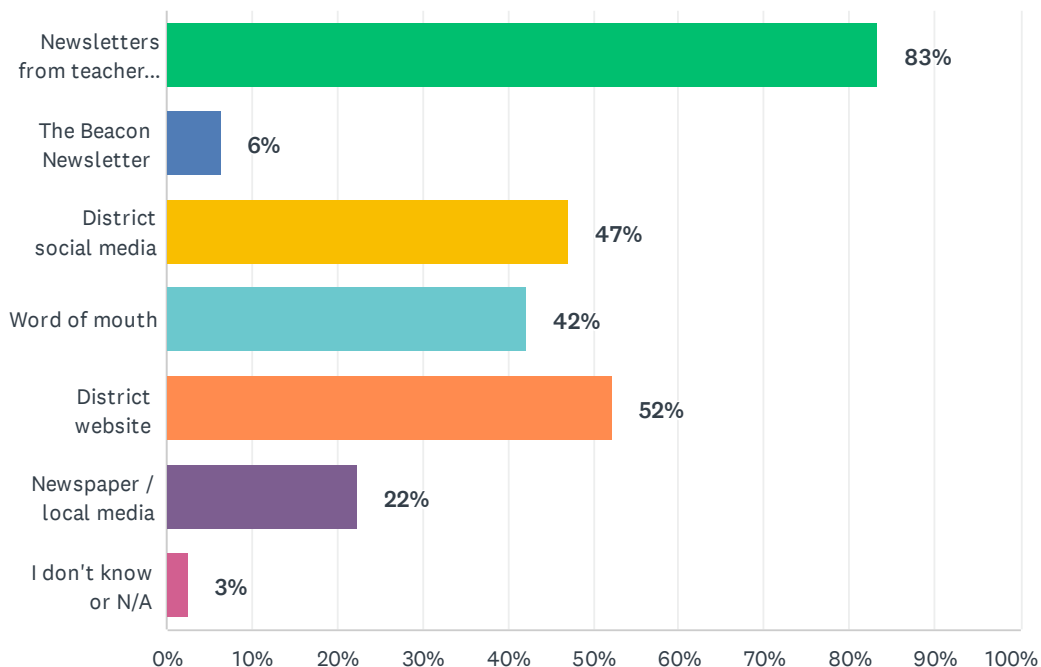

Q3 How do you receive information about Grand Haven Area Public Schools? (check all that apply)

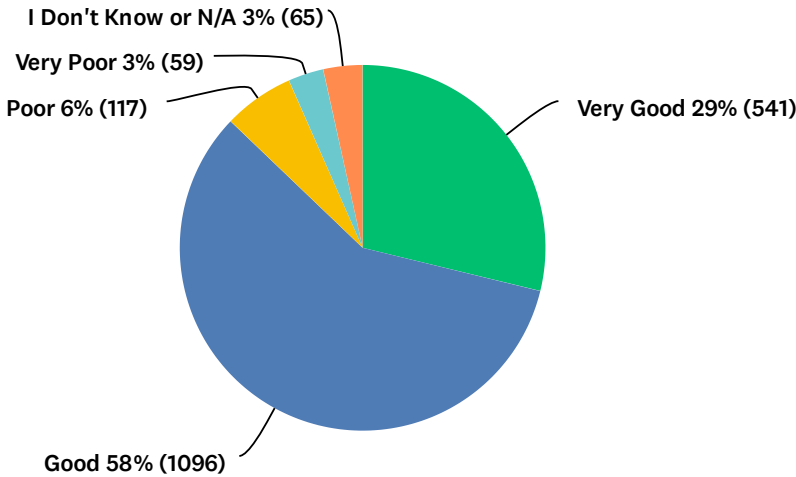

Q4 Based on your experience, please rate the district's overall performance the past few years in regard to quality of education and programs.

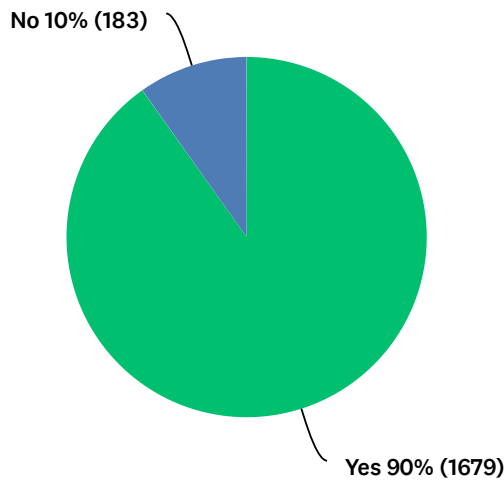

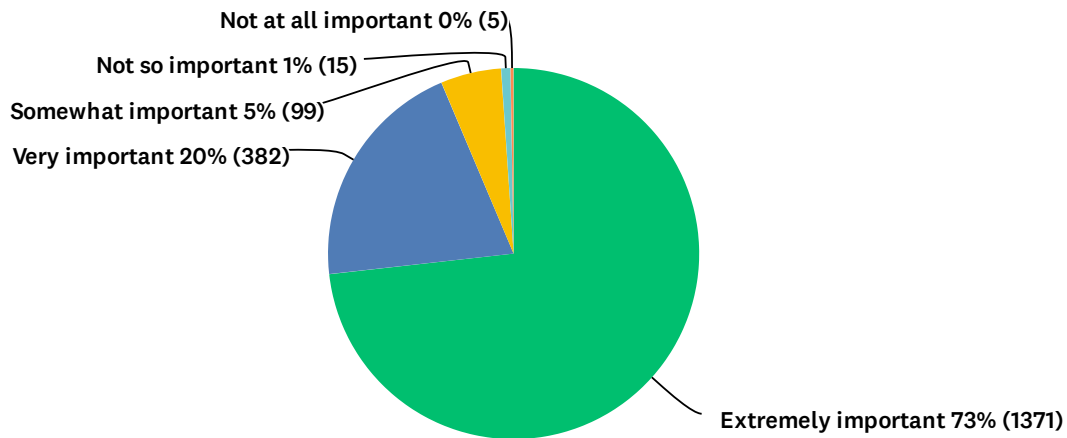

Q6 Rate the importance of school building secure entrances, including identifiable front entrances and control of visitors.

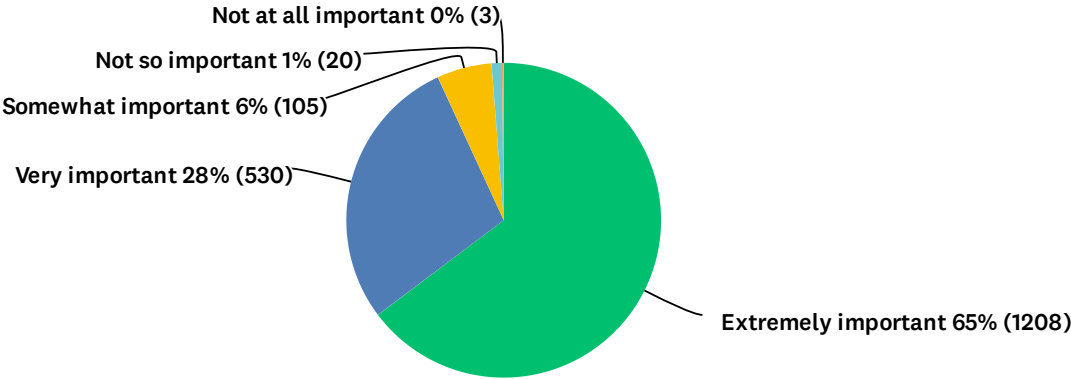

Q7 Rate the importance of school facilities that support educational programs.

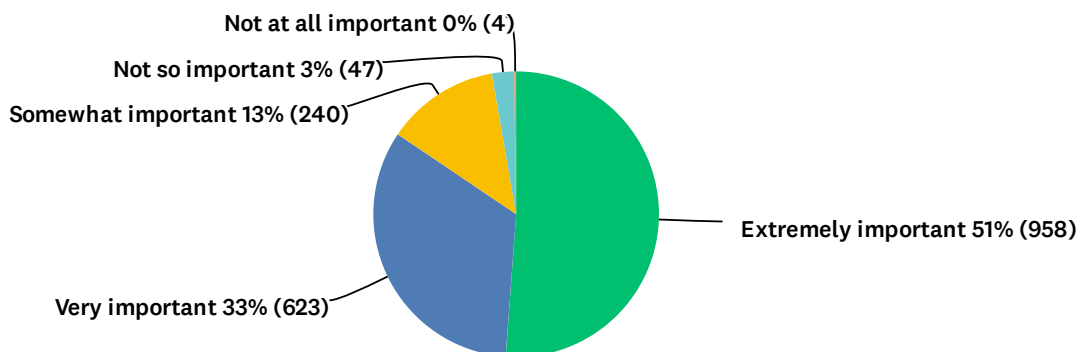

Q8 Rate the importance of educational technology to support teaching and learning.

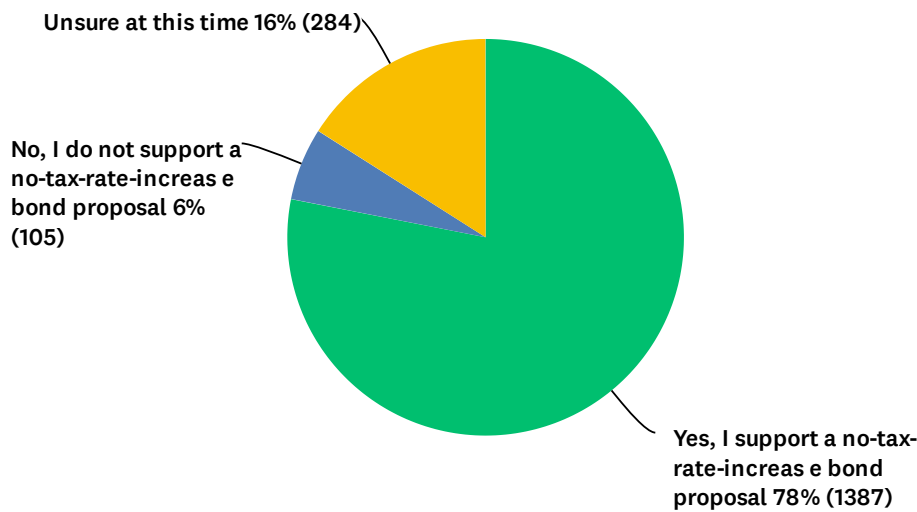
